Sparkling Wine

Vilarnau Brut Gold Organic Cava. Spain

Aromas of green apple, pear and subtle notes of elderflower. Full bodied, beautifully balanced and with a long stream of fine, persistent bubbles.

On the nose, it displays the primary aromas that are typical of a delicate rosé cava: the subtleties of violets and roses in combination with ripe red berries: strawberries, raspberries and blueberries. On the palate it is smooth, very creamy, fresh and elegant.

Marqués del Puente Nuevo Tempranillo Garnacha Rosé. Spain

A fresh, ripe strawberry fruit character make this an approachable style of rosé.

This rosé, a blend of gently pressed Turbiana and Rondinella grapes, hails from the latter. Head winemaker and family member Giancarlo Tommasi carefully vinifies the wine

Fruity aromas and flavours of ripe strawberries and some spicy clove/ nutmeg notes. Soft, well-rounded palate, in a medium style.

Red Wine

Marqués del Puente Nuevo Tempranillo, Garnacha. Spain

Raspberry and black cherry fruits on the nose that also emerge on the palate, complemented by a touch of spice.

Abadia Mercier Tempranillo Merlot. Spain

Bright red cherry colour, with powerful and fruity aromas, reminiscent of red fruits. Silky palate bursting with red fruit flavours.

Beronia Rioja Tempranillo Joven. Spain

On the nose, aromas of cherry with hints of spice including white pepper and notes of tobacco. On the palate, the wine is fresh and very fruit forward, balanced with notes of cinnamon and spice.

Rioja Reserva, Muga. Spain

An enticing and complex nose of pain grille, pencil lead, and blackberry leads into an elegant wine with layers of flavour, fruit and sweet-spice with ripe and integrated tannins and a lengthy finish.

Marqués de Murrieta Rioja Gran Reserva. Spain

Marqués de Murrieta began in 1852 and is the oldest estate to stand in Rioja Alta. The winemaker here today is Maria Vargas, who was Tim Atkin MW's Winemaker of the Year in 2017. This is a full-bodied and generous Gran Reserva Rioja, with flavours of red and dark fruits, spicy oak and vanilla.

Lua Nova Lisboa Red. Portugal

Intensely aromatic ripe black and red fruits; juicy plums and dark berry with fine tannins and a long lasting smooth finish.

Terres d'Azur Merlot. France

Rich berry and plum aromas with hints of spice and chocolate lead on to a soft, smooth palate with generous fruit and smoky notes.

Pavillion des Trois Arches Merlot. South of France

Richly flavoured, packed full of plump plum and cedar notes. Ripe and generous tannins tie this wine together.

Côtes du Rhône Vidal-Fleury. Rhone

Brilliant garnet in colour, with a classic Rhône nose of bramble fruits and heady spice. The medium-bodied palate has fresh and snappy red fruit surrounded by firm and persistent tannins.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Domaine Durieu. Rhone **£80.00**

With typical Chateauneuf power, the wine delivers a fresh and spicy nose of red cherry embellished with notes of sage and wild thyme. The palate is equally powerful, with sinuous tannins and huge length.

Ségla, Margaux. Bordeaux **£100.00**

It is a wine with excellent concentration and poise. Showing fragrant notes of ripe fruits, violets and cedar with beautiful length and delicate tannins. With great structure and balance and a long finish

Château Fonplégade, Saint-Émilion Grand Cru. Bordeaux **£145.00**

Predominantly Merlot with just enough Cabernet Franc to add structure, this blend is made from hand-picked grapes from their oldest vines. As a result, it's full-bodied and plush, with notes of blackcurrant, blueberry, cocoa and fresh tobacco and a long, smooth finish.

Chateau Pichon-Longueville 'Les Griffons de Pichon Baron'. Bordeaux **£160.00**

The Cabernet Sauvignon grapes that dominate the blend primarily come from gravel soils near Gironde estuary. Expect a full-bodied wine with flavours of blackcurrant, blueberries, liquorice and hints of cedar and tobacco.

Louis Latour Château Corton Grancey Grand Cru 2013. Burgundy **£250.00**

Maison Louis Latour is synonymous with Burgundy wine. Corton's structured Pinots are unrivalled in finesse and this is no exception. Expect aromas of black cherry, liquorice, coffee and clove, plus bold flavours of blackcurrant and clove, silky tannins and a persistent finish.

Apericena Appassimento. Italy **£28.00**

Intense red in colour, with a complex bouquet reminiscent of cherries, raspberries and redcurrants. Full-bodied, it is supple and well-balanced, with layers upon layers of dark fruit, fine tannins and a long and lingering finish.

Famiglie Venete Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore Organic. Italy **£40.00**

Valpolicella Ripasso is made from fresh Corvina grapes, re-fermented with semi-dried ex-Amarone grape skins. The dried grapes add a touch of sweetness and body, making for this famously bold and flavourful style.

Tommasi 'Il Sestante' Amarone, Valpolicella. Italy **£100.00**

Tommasi have prime sites in some of Valpolicella's best hillside vineyards. It's on these that they produce dazzling and award-winning Amarone. Their signature style is elegance over power. Expect a full-bodied palate, smooth tannins and intense aromas of ripe cherries and plums.



Calusari Pinot Noir. Romania

Light, soft and welcoming nose of autumn fruits. soft smooth & spicy flavours throughout with generous soft red fruit flavours & a lovely elegant finish.

Copper Kingdom Barossa Shiraz. Australia

£32.00

Full bodied, jammy and fruity. It's an intense, powerful explosion of blackcurrants, blackberries. Pair with autumn's heartiest meals to test your next steak's mettle.

Ghost in the Machine Malbec-Viognier. South Africa

£40.00

Herbaceous with hints of fynbos, rosemary and tobacco leaf, spiced or marinated red meats with a biltong coating. The palate bursts with plum and cherries - smokey.

Terra Vega Gran Reserva Cabernet Sauvignon. Chile

£30.00

Complex and intense nose, where aromas of red and black fruits, strawberry, blackberry and blueberry predominate, combined with spiced notes of white pepper and nutmeg. The palate is elegant, with round tannins and hints of chocolate provided by 12 months ageing in French and American oak.

Camino Acero Malbec, Argentina

£24.50

This is an elegant, juicy Malbec with lots of pure blackcurrant fruit character. A little grip of tannin helps balance the wine.

Norton Lo Tengo Malbec, Argentina

£32.00

Rich ruby red in color with purple hints. Fresh fruit, cinnamon and cherry aromas. Very attractive velvety feel on the palate, delicious finish.

Viñalba Reserve Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina

This wine wraps itself around every corner of your mouth with its ripe dark plum fruits, sweet tannins and dark chocolate and mocha. Flavours linger for a long time.



White Wine

Marqués del Puente Nuevo Sauvignon Blanc, Airen. Spain

With a subtle floral scent on the nose this white has flavours of melon, citrus fruits and a touch of fennel.

Conde De Castile Blanco Rioja. Spain

A balance of floral and fruit aromas. Pear notes alongside quince with cream and honey in the background. Mineral nuances bring complexity and intensity.

Beronia Rueda Verdejo. Spain

Intensely aromatic, displaying notes of citrus and white fruit along with herbaceous fennel aromas typical of the grape variety. Richly textured on the palate, it is fresh and elegant, with a slight touch of bitterness on the finish.

Rioja Blanco, Muga. Spain

Complex and toasted aromas with fresh, vibrant fruits give way to zesty lime, spicy and vanilla, toasted oak flavours, fresh acidity, and a refreshing spicy finish.

Ormarine Sea Pearl Picpoul. South of France

A snappy nose of lemon and lime fruit, with vibrant green apple. A racy wine with a lip-tingling finish.

Planalto White Reserva, Douro. Portugal

Dry and delicate, but possessing an interesting aromatic intensity and complexity, with overtones of blossom. The fruit is predominantly citrus, with soft pear and melon flavours completing the picture.

Grand Ardèche Chardonnay, Louis Latour. South of France

Yellow-green in colour, with a subtle nose of vanilla. On the palate there are ripe apple and peach fruits with a nutty, buttery creamy texture and notes of vanilla and spice. A powerful and complex wine.

Domain Patureaux Pouilly Fume. Loire

Domaine Patureaux is boutique winemaking at its best. On this small, family owned estate, the father-and-son team has created a powerful, refreshing Pouilly-Fume with bold aromas of pear, peach and apricot, a long, rich finish and a delicious smokiness.

Elegant dry white wine, pale yellow colour, aromas of white flowers and green apple and refreshing citrus flavours.

Louis Latour Organic Bourgogne Côte d'Or Blanc. Burgundy

£68.00

Made organically from young vines, this is fermented in oak but aged in stainless steel tanks. Expect plenty of fresh and fruity flavours. Discover lively notes of citrus, almond and honey, with a mineral finish.

Gufetto Pinot Grigio. Italy

Straw yellow, with hints of exotic white fruit, white floral scents, fresh and fragrant wine

Boschetto Gavi di Gavi DOCG. Italy

£36.00

Bright, clean apple and pear aromas on the nose, a citrus fresh palate, delicately herbaceous, touch of a mineral twang on the finish.

Calusari Pinot Grigio. Romania

£28.00

Lovely opulent aromas of grapefruit and peach follow through to a lithe body, with loads of fruit as well as abundant melon and apple character and citrusy acidity

Featherdrop Sauvignon Blanc. New Zealand

£32.00

Lively aromas of gooseberry, passionfruit, grapefruit and crisp red capsicum. Bold flavours of lemon, lime, grapefruit and gooseberry tantalise the palate and provide a refreshing clean finish.

Greywacke Sauvignon, Marlborough. New Zealand

£65.00

Intense aromatics of melon, peach and papaya are accompanied by hints of tomato leaf and capsicum. The palate is crisp but remarkably mouth-filling, a small portion of the wine having been oak fermented.

Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough. New Zealand

£80.00

A wine full of fresh herbal aromas and layers of ripe guava and tropical fruit. Gooseberries and passion fruit on the medium-full body; the palate is succulent and crisp with a long flavoursome finish.



Toast & Honey Chardonnay. California **£32.00**

Formidable Californian Chardonnay, with delicious toasted vanilla notes and honeyed stone fruit and baked apple. Pair with baked cheeses. Rich butterscotch and toasted oak on the nose, crème brulee with some bosc pear on the palate, long flavorful finish.

Kleinkloof Chenin Blanc. South Africa **£25.00**

Very attractive nose with lots of tropical fruits such as pineapple, guava and citrus fruit, carrying on to the crisp, refreshing palate.

Klein Constantia Sauvignon Blanc, Constantia. South Africa **£40.00**

A light green appearance with ripe tropical aromas of pineapple and passionfruit. The palate is classically Sauvignon with its racy acidity and the finish is clean and refreshing.

Chardonnay Gran Reserva, Terra Vega. Chile **£26.50**

This is rich and mouthfilling with ripe banana, vanilla and apple flavours brought together by toasted undertones.

Morande Pionero Chardonnay Reserva. Chile **£26.00**

This cool-climate Chardonnay has a bright, citrusy aroma with pear and green apple fruit. The palate is medium-bodied and nicely rounded, returning to citrus on the fresh, clean finish.

Norton Lo Tengo Torrontes. Argentina **£25.00**

Golden yellow with greenish notes. Fine rose and jasmine aromas. Well- balanced acidity, round and balanced with a delicate finish.

Altura White Blend, Norton. Argentina **£48.00**

The exotic citrus aromas are followed on the palate by flavours of tangerine, orange peel and white flowers. There is some grip and texture from the skins and a moreish saline, mineral quality to the finish.
